What is a Growth Group Leader wanting to achieve?

What is the role of a Growth Group Assistant Leader?

How this will happen?

Bible, Prayer, Community.

Bible

- Help the group study the Bible well.
- Be active and helpful in Bible discussion.
- Help draw out the engagement of others in your group.
- Set an example to the group by following the Growth Group Leader's direction, and by engaging attentively.
- Discuss regularly with the leader how well the group members are engaging with the Word of God, and how they might improve/grow.
- It may be possible for the Assistant to lead the occasional study, but it is not necessarily required.

Prayer

- Pray regularly for your group members.
- Discuss regularly with the Growth Group Leader how the group members might grow in the discipline of prayer.

Community

- Assist the Growth Group Leader in fostering a warm & loving sense of community in your group, actively stimulating conversation.
- Discuss regularly with the leader how the group members might grow in love for one another (spiritual and practical).
- Help model selflessness and love for others.

Additional Responsibilities:

- Be regular at Growth Group.
- Seek to grow in your Christian life.
- Attend the Growth Group Leaders' Launches at the beginning of each term.
- Attend training when appropriate.
