



Luke 6:17-26: Seeing Life Jesus' Way

A key idea - Often what we called blessed and cursed is thrown upside down by Jesus, the key is to recognise Jesus who will rule the coming kingdom

Context: What are some things you think attracted people to Jesus as he went from place to place?

Read Luke 6:17-26

1. What strikes you about Jesus' words?
2. What clues are there that he isn't just talking about anyone in poverty?
3. What is the warning for us in a rich country?
 - a. Do you find it hard to agree with Jesus here? How so?
4. Jesus' teaching seems to be particularly focused on the twelve disciples (compare v. 20, 27). How does this help us have discernment about what Christian leaders should be like?
 - a. ... how Christian leaders should not be?
5. What do you think are some key things to seeing life Jesus' way?
 - a. How can you foster those things in your life?
 - b. What are some things that hinder us from seeing life Jesus' way?
 - c. How might you go about getting rid of those things in your life?

Pray together that we would see life Jesus' way, knowing that he is the Son of Man, the ruler of the coming eternal kingdom.
