Date	Lesson	Key Learning Point
18th Oct	The disciples were Jesus' special friends. Matthew 4:18-22; 9:9; 10:1-4	The Disciples were special friends of Jesus. Friends of Jesus follow him.
25th	Jesus wanted children to be his friends. Matthew 19:13-15	Jesus isn't just for grownups. Jesus wants children to be his friends too!
1st Nov	Zacchaeus. Luke 19:1-10	Jesus wanted Zacchaeus to be his friend. Zacchaeus changed when he became a friend of Jesus.
8th	Mary and Martha Luke 10: 38-42	Mary & Martha were friends of Jesus. Jesus was pleased that Mary listened to him. She chose the best thing! Friends of Jesus listen to Jesus.
15th	Jesus washed his disciples feet. John 13: 3-30	Jesus washed his disciples feet, by doing this he showed his friends how to love and serve each other. Friends of Jesus love others.
22nd	Jesus wants his friends to tell others about him. Matthew 28:18-20, Mark 16:15	Jesus wants his friends to tell others about him.
29th	A promise to Abraham Genesis 12:1-3, 15:1-6	God promised to bless the whole world through Abraham's family. God keeps that promise in Jesus.
6th Dec	A promise to David 2 Samuel 7	God promised David that someone from his family would live forever as God's King. God keeps that promise in Jesus.
13th	Isaiah shares God's promise Isaiah 9:6-7	Isaiah was a prophet (one of God's special messengers). Isaiah shared God's promise of the forever King with God's people. Jesus is God's forever King.
20th	A promise to Mary & Joseph Luke 1:26-38, Matthew 1:18-25	An angel told Mary that she was going to have a baby, God's son Jesus. An angel told Joseph that Mary would have a baby. He would be the promised Saviour.
27th	The Promised King is born Luke 2:1-21	The promised King is born - Jesus, the saviour.
