Abraham would have lots of descendants.- Genesis 24, 25:19-26

29th Mar- God calls his people to live Holy lives. God was with Joseph. God is with us. We ought

to live Holy lives.- Genesis 37, 39

5th April- God is a God of Grace. He is a God who saves. He saved the Israelites.
