- 3) Why did God call us? (vs 14)
- 4) What do you think it means to share in the glory of Jesus Christ?
- 5) Paul says because God has chosen us to be saved and gave us his Spirit so that we can share in Jesus glory. What should we do in light of these truths? (hint: verse 15)
- 6) If we need to hold firm to the teachings (God's word) to stand firm until the end, what should be one of the most important things to us? Is reading God's word a priority in your life?
- 7) What are some steps you can take to be in God's word more? (tip- write out your week and put in times where you have spare time to read the bible)

Pray:
