**Study to do with parents:**

- Look at Exodus 12:1-30: can you summarise what happens here?
- Look at 1 Corinthians 5:7B. What does that tell us about Jesus?
- What could it mean if Jesus is our “Passover lamb”?
- In the Old Testament, God did not punish his people who had sacrificed a lamb. God “passed over” their house and did not bring any anger or punishment into their lives. How does this point to Jesus?
