# God Made People

**Reference:** Genesis 2

**Main Point:** My God is so BIG, He made everyone.

### Activities to do together:

- Walk around the house and find some photos or look through your photos on the computer/phone. Who are they and what are they doing? Talk about how BIG and amazing God is and that he made all people.
- Print off some photos of people your child knows or cut out pictures of people from magazines and create a collage of people God made. Write 'God Made People' on the paper
- Make some basic cookie dough and make people with cookie cutters. Decorate before or after cooking.
- Provide some markers, crayons or paint and a mirror. Ask the child to look in the mirror and draw what they see. After they have finished ask "Who made you?" and write God made me

**Bible:** Read the account of how God made people from a good Children's Bible. This may mean you reread the same passage from last week or that you read from a different children's bible. Look at the pictures and ask questions about things that God made. Finally ask them "Who did God make last?" (People!) Yes, all people are made in God's likeness.

**Pray:** Dear Father God, Thank you for making me. Thank you for making my family and friends. Thank you for making all people. Help me to remember that you made all people and that you love them all. Amen.

### Something for Sermon time:

- Watch this week's video for under 5's if you have an extra device or watch at another time together. ☺
- On an coloured/plain sheet of paper, write God Made People. Make a people paper chain on coloured paper and have your child glue the people onto the backing sheet, draw faces and the colour or glue cut up pieces of paper for clothes [How to make paper chain people: Easy kids craft](#)
- Pull out some playdough and a gingerbread cookie cutter and make some people. Use playdough to make faces and hair. Kids might like to add some other animals that God made from the previous week. If you have the ability to laminate you could print out these free [playdough mats](#) for kids to decorate.

## God Made People

**Reference:** Genesis 2

**Main Point:** My **God** is so **BIG**, He made everyone.

**An activity to do together:** Make a garden using a cardboard box or tray, flowers, and other things from your garden. Collect some people and animals from a playset if you have one, or make them together, from playdough or cardboard. Using the garden that you have assembled, ask your children to point to the things that God made. Add Adam to the garden and tell your children about him - that God made him, about his special friendship with God, where he lived and the job God gave him to do. Add Eve to the garden and tell them about her - that God made her, her friendship with Him and Adam, where she lived and the special job God gave her to do. Let's read about it in the Bible

**Bible:** Read the account of God making Adam and Eve from your children's Bible.

### Discussion:

- 1. Who made Adam and Eve?** *God made Adam and Eve. He wanted them to be his special friends, to live in his beautiful garden and to look after his wonderful plants and creatures. He could make Adam and Eve and everything, because he is so big, so mighty and so good.*
- 2. When you make something, who does that thing belong to? Me. Who is the boss of that thing?** *Me, because I made it.*
- 3. Who else did God make?** *God made you and God made me and all our family. God made everyone and because he made us, we all belong to Him.*
- 4. Who is our boss?** *God is our boss because he made us and we belong to Him. The Bible tells us that he loves and cares for us and He knows what is best for us. He is our King!*

**Pray together:** Thank you God for making me and that I belong to you. Please help me to be friends with you and to live with you as my king.

**Memory verse:** Isaiah 6:3 "Holy, Holy, Holy is the Lord almighty. The whole earth is full of His glory". Practice saying it together. Maybe, the children are able to say it on their own.

### Ideas for sermon time:

- \* Watch this week's video for under 5's if you have an extra device or watch at another time together. ☺
- \* Decorate some paper chain people that you have cut out, with faces, hair, clothing etc.
- \* Draw pictures of themselves, family members, friends, teachers,
- \* Make play dough people, animals, flowers, trees, mountains etc.
- \* Make a collage of people, from pictures you've cut out of magazines, or found on the internet.
