God knows all about everything he has made. God knows all about Me!

Reference: Psalm 139

Main Point: My God is so BIG, He knows everything.

Activity to do together:

- Look at pictures of your child from the time they were a baby to now. Discuss that God made them and He knows all about them. God knew them when they were a tiny baby, and He knows all about them now. God even knew them before they were born!
- Draw an outline of your child's hand (or foot!). Discuss how God made their hand special, different to everybody else's. He gave them brown/blonde hair and blue/green eyes. God has known all about them from the time their hands were tiny. You may like to keep this hand drawing for your child to colour during sermon time.
- Use playdough, Duplo or blocks to make models of your child's favourite things (flowers, animals, food etc.). Discuss how God made all these things, and God knows that your child loves these things. God knows all about your child.

Bible: Read an account of Creation (Genesis 1) from a good children's bible. Discuss that God made the whole world, and everything and everyone in it.

Read Psalm 139:1-18 [Here](#) is a link to a version from the NIV Little Kids' Adventure Bible which may be easier for your child to understand. Discuss that God knows everything about us. God knows when we stand up and when we sit down. He knows when we wake up and when we go to sleep. He knows what we are thinking. There is nothing that God does not know about us.

Pray: Thank you God that you made everything. Thank you that you made me and you know all about me.

Something for Sermon time:

- Watch this week's video for under 5's if you have an extra device or watch at another time together.
- Have your child colour in the outline of their hand/foot made earlier. You can also use torn pieces of paper for your child to glue within the outline to make a collage.

God knows all about everything he has made. God knows all about me!

Reference: Psalm 139

Main Point: My God is so BIG, He knows everything.

Activities to do together:

- Draw an outline of your child's hand (or foot!). Discuss how God made their hand special, different to everybody else's. He gave them brown/blonde hair and blue/green eyes. God has known all about them from the time their hands were tiny.
- Use playdough, Duplo or blocks to make models of your child's favourite things (flowers, animals, food etc.). Discuss how God made all these things, and God knows that your child loves these things. God knows all about your child.
- Sit, stand, speak game: similar to rock, paper, scissors but the actions are sitting, standing, or speaking (use a hand action for speaking). As you play, discuss how God knows everything they do. He knows when they sit, stand, speak, and how they live. He knows it even before they do it.

Bible: Read Psalm 139. [Here](#) is an excerpt from the NIV Little Kids' Adventure Bible that may be easier to understand.

Discussion:

1. **Who created you?** *God made you. He chose your hair colour, etc everything about you.*
2. **Do you know if [insert friend's name] is playing right now?** *No, unlike God, we can't know what everybody is doing all the time.*
3. **Does God know when you are happy/sad/sleeping/playing?** *God knows all about you and cares for you.*
3. **How does God know all about us?** (accept answers) Because he's God and he made us! Our God is so big, he knows everything.

Pray: Thank you God that you made me. Thank you that you are so big and know everything and care for us.

Something for sermon time:

- Watch this week's video for under 5's if you have an extra device or watch at another time together. 😊
- Have your child colour in the outline of their hand/foot made earlier. You can also use torn pieces of paper for your child to glue within the outline to make a collage.



- Face collage: print/draw the face outline. Provide your child with collage material (coloured wool, ripped red paper, googly) to glue for their hair, eyes, and mouth.
