**Focused questions:** (you may like to ask your parents for help)

Read: numbers 22: 4-6

- 5) Who are the people Balak wants to put a curse on?
  - 6) Why does he want Balaam to put a curse on the Israelites?
  - 7) Read genesis 12:2- What did God promise to Abram?
  - 8) Will Balaam (a human) stop God from keeping his promise to bless his people?
  - 9) What does God say to Balaam? (look at Numbers 22:12)
  - 10) Do you believe that no human can cause God to break his promises to you?

**Optional extra passage**

Read: Romans 8:31-39

- 11) What is Paul convinced about? (read verse 37-39)
- 12) Why do you think Paul is so convinced that nothing will separate us from the love of Jesus?

God makes a promise to us, God says that if we trust in Jesus nothing can separate us from his love. We saw in Numbers 22 that no human can stop God from keeping his promises because he is more powerful than humans.

- 13) How should knowing this change the way you live?

Pray:

Thank God that no human can stop him from keeping his promises

Ask God to help you rest in his promise of salvation and trust that nothing can separate you from his love.
