**General Questions:**

  - 4) Are there hard times in your life when you doubt God is keeping his promises to you? What can you remind yourself of?

**Focused questions:** (you may like to ask your parents for help)

Read: Deuteronomy 28:1-2

- 5) What is the promise that God makes to the Isrealites?
- 6) What did God command the Israelites to live like to be a part of the promises God gave them?

Read Deuteronomy 28:15

- 7) When will the Israelites not be apart the promises God made to them?
  - 8) Did God tell them what would happen if they disobeyed him?
  - 9) Does this mean that God is still faithful in keeping his promises to the Israelites? Why do you think that?

**Optional extra passage**

Read Isaiah 41:10

- 10) What is the promise God makes to all christians?
- 11) Can we trust this promise even when life is hard and not going the way we want it to? Why can we trust this promise?

**Pray:**

Ask God to help you trust that he is faithful to his promises always.

Thank God for how faithful he is.

Thank God that you can trust in his promises to you even this hard time

Pick one part of Isaiah 41:10 and thank God for that.
