



## Hold on to the salvation that Jesus brings. Hebrews 2:1-4

### Craft

1. Get the kids to trace around their hand on some card. Cut out.
2. Write the phrase “Hold on to the salvation that Jesus brings” on the palm.
3. Stick coloured pompoms or coloured paper onto the nail section of the fingers to represent the Gospel (Green for creation, black for sin, red for the blood of Jesus, white for resurrection, yellow for Heaven)
4. Display the hand by attaching two pegs to the bottom so that it can stand up.
