

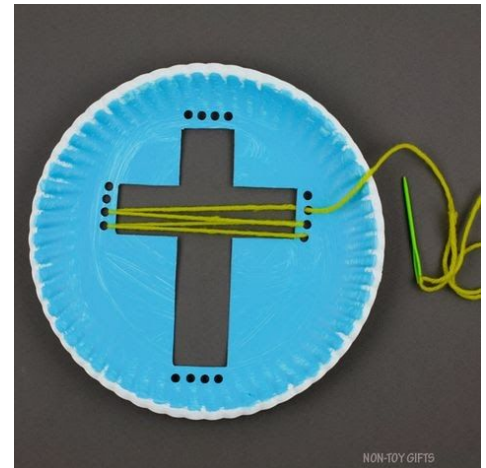


Jesus' sacrifice works because it is able to permanently deal with our sin. Hebrews 10:11-14

Colour the attached sheet.

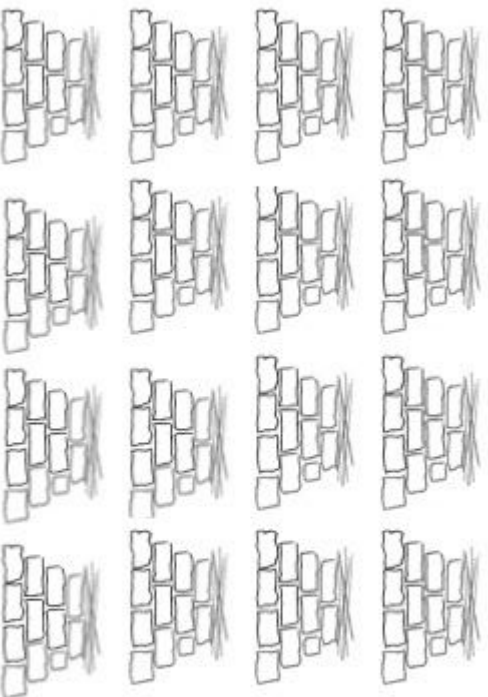
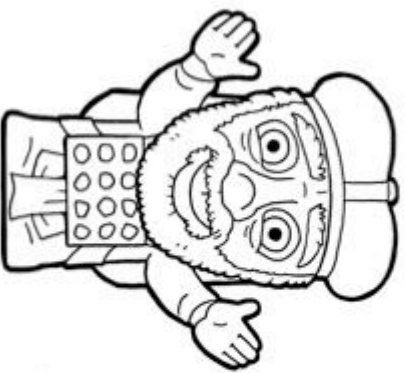
Activity

Because of Jesus' sacrifice God doesn't count our sin against us and it has lost its power. Get some scrap paper and write the word sin on it. Play with a partner and make sure everyone has a similar number of scrunched up balls of paper with the word sin on it. I recommend at least 10 each. Put a line between the two people. The game starts by tossing your scrunched up paper over the line, one at a time. The aim of the game is to be the first person with no paper.

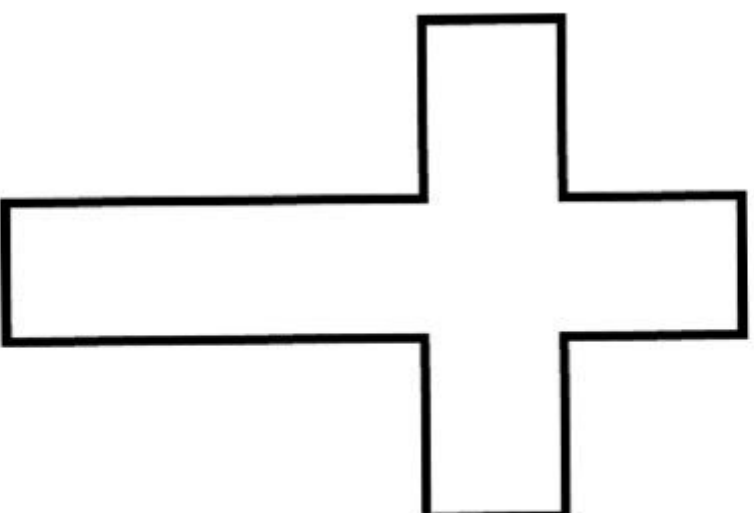
Family Discussion
