### Colouring

### Craft

Print the attached sheet. Make some small cards- some need to be blank and some need to have the word Jesus on them. Place those cards face down. Play a game like snakes and ladders. When a player lands on a "sin" square they pick up one of the cards. If they pick up a Jesus card God's anger is turned away and they are safe. If they pick up a blank card they need to go back three spaces. The first person to the finish wins.

3. In v 21 we read about how people are supposed to respond to God. What does it say?
4. How can someone be saved from God's anger?
5. Are you safe from God's anger at sin?
