Craft

1. Cut a short strip of card 2.5cm x 12.5cm.
2. In pale writing write “suffering”
3. Cut a longer strip of card 2.5cm x 25cm.
4. In bright text write “future glory”
5. Tape the ends of each circle together to create a circle
6. Use sticky tape to attach a paper straw to the inside of each circle.
