Date	Lesson	Key Learning Point
5th May	God knows all about the things he has made. References: Ps50:11, Matthew 10:29	God knows about all things because he made all things.
12th	God knows all about me. Reference: Psalm 139	God made me. He knows all about me.
19th	God knows my friends Reference: Psalm139, John 10:4	God knows my friends too. God knows everything and everyone
26th	We can talk to God References: 1 Thess 5:16-18,Eph 6:18	We can talk to God whenever we want. Anywhere, anytime, no matter how we are feeling.
2nd June	God hears us when we talk to him References: 1 John 5:14, 1 Peter 3:12	God hears us when we talk to him. He is never too busy to listen. God loves it when we talk to him.
9th	Saying 'Thank you God' Reference: 1Thess 5:16-17, Psalm 107:1	There are lots of things to thank God for. All good things come from him.
16th	Saying 'Sorry' God Reference: 1 John 1:8-10	We all do things which we need to say sorry to God for. God made us and we belong to him. God is the boss, but sometimes we disobey him. We need to remember to say 'Sorry' God.
23rd	Saying 'Please' God References: Phillipians 4:6-7 Matthew 6:9-13	We can ask God for things, for ourselves and others.
30th	God is kind References: Acts 14:17, Psalm 111: 4-5	God is kind
7th July	God is good References: Psalm 100:4-5, 119:68	God is good. He is good all the time. He always does good things. He is never bad.
14th	God is great References: 2 Sam 7:22, Psalm 145:3, Jeremiah 10:6	God is great. There is no one like him. He is greater than anyone else.
21st	God is always with us. References: Psalm 46:7, Hebrews 13:5	Although we can't see God. He is always with us.

Date	Lesson	Key Learning Points
5th May	God Made the World. Gen 1:1-2:4, Psalm 104, Psalm 146:6, Rev 4:11	God made everything. Because God made everything, everything belongs to him. God is the boss.
12th	God made people. Gen2:4-25, 3:20, Psalm100	God made Adam and Eve. God made everyone. Because God made us, we belong to him. God loves us. God is the boss.
19th	Things went wrong. Genesis 3, Romans 3:23, Romans 5:8, Romans 5:12-20	Adam and Eve disobeyed God and he punished them. God's world was broken because they didn't let God be the boss. We disobey God too. We all have the sin problem. God sent Jesus to fix the sin problem.
26th	Noah Genesis 6:1-9:17, Rom 5:8	God's world was broken because of the sin problem. God sent a flood he wanted to start again. God chose to save one man and his family - Noah. Noah listened to God and obeyed him. He built a big boat like God said and God kept him, his family and lots of animals safe. God promised to never flood the whole earth again. The flood didn't fix the sin problem. God sent Jesus to fix the sin problem.
2nd June	In the beginning - (Revision) Genesis 1-3, Psalm 100, Genesis 6:5-10, 7:1:5, 8:15-17, Romans 3:23, 5:8, Rev 4:11	Aim to revise lessons. God made it. God is the boss. We broke it. The problem of sin. The flood didn't fix the sin problem. God sent Jesus to fix the sin problem.
9th	Abraham leaves his country. Genesis 12:1-7, Matthew ch1	God made some big promises to Abraham. God promised Abraham a land to live in, a big, big family and that one day the whole world would be blessed through him. Abraham believed God and did what he said. God keeps all his promises.The whole world is blessed through Jesus. Jesus fixes the sin problem.
16th	The birth of Isaac. Genesis 15:1-6, 18:1-15, 21:1-7 Matthew ch1	God promised Abraham that he would have a big, big family with more people than there are stars in the sky. Abraham and Sarah were very old. God kept his promise and gave them Isaac. God always keeps his promises. Many years later God sent Jesus. Jesus was a part of Abraham's family and we are too if we belong to Jesus.
23rd	Joseph - From Canaan to Egypt	Abraham's family continued to grow. God was keeping his promises. Joseph was one





	Genesis 37:1-36, 39:1-6	of Abraham's great grandchildren. Some hard things happened to Joseph but God was with him. God looked after him. God cares for his people. God is in charge. Many years later God sent Jesus. Hard things happened to Jesus. Jesus died on a cross, but God was with Jesus. God was in charge. God used Jesus' death for good. Jesus died to save us from our sin.
30th	Joseph in Egypt Genesis 39-41	Joseph was given important jobs to do in Egypt. God was with Joseph, God looked after Joseph. God had a plan. Many years later God sent JesusGod had a plan.
7th July	Abraham and Joseph Revision. Genesis 12:1-5; 15:5; 21:1-3 37:3-4, 23-28, 36 39:2-4; 42:1-3; 45:4-11, 16-18	God provided for Joseph and his family in Egypt. A happy end to the story! Things had been hard for Joseph but God was with him and looked after him. God had a plan that worked for good. Also revise Abraham. Emphasise God keeps his promises. God cares for his people. God is in charge. We can trust him. Many years later God sent Jesus
14th	Moses the baby. Exodus 1:6-14, 22; 2:1-10 Matthew 2:13	God looked after baby Moses and kept him safe. God kept Moses safe because he had a special job for Moses to do. Many years later God kept another baby safe Jesus
21st	Moses and the burning bush. Exodus 3:1-4:20, also Exodus 2:15, 23-25; 5:1-2; 7:1-7; 12:29-32	God had a special job for Moses. God wanted Moses to help God's people leave Egypt. God was going to use Moses to save his people. Even though Moses was afraid he trusted God and obeyed him. Many years later God sent Jesus to save his people.
