

EV BEQUESTS - General Information

To support our Gospel Mission you may wish to leave a gift to EV Church as a beneficiary in your Will.

If you are creating or reviewing your own Will in consultation with your solicitor, you may wish to consider a specific gift. We suggest the following wording:

"I give \$_____ to EV Church Ltd (ABN 94 880 354 126) of 331 Terrigal Drive, Erina NSW for the general purposes thereof and the receipt executed on the behalf of EV Church Ltd shall be sufficient discharge for my Trustee and my Trustee shall not be bound to see the application of the said gift."

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Your Will is an important legal document that allows you to choose who should benefit from your estate and the person(s) most suitable to administer it (the Executor) according to your wishes .
- Your Will should reflect your current situation, be reviewed regularly by your solicitor and remain up to date, especially if circumstances change.
- You should choose an Executor who is unlikely to pre-decease you, who is readily available and where possible, in tune with your wishes.
- Assets that pass through the estate are called Estate Assets, whilst assets not controlled by the Will are called Non Estate assets. Examples of Non Estate assets may include assets held in joint tenancy, a life insurance policy or superannuation benefits where you have a nominated beneficiary.
- Keep your Family and loved ones informed of your wishes and intentions. Importantly, your Will whilst honouring loved ones, may also give voice to your beliefs and values and why your gift/bequest is important to you.
- Gifts via your Will may be structured:
 - As a specific gift, i.e. an amount of money .
 - As a percentage of your estate.
 - After taking care of loved ones, the remainder of your estate (either \$ or %) may be left for purposes of a gift.
 - The above options should be discussed with your solicitor.
- Other important legal documents to consider in discussion with your solicitor, are Powers of Attorney and Enduring Guardianship .
