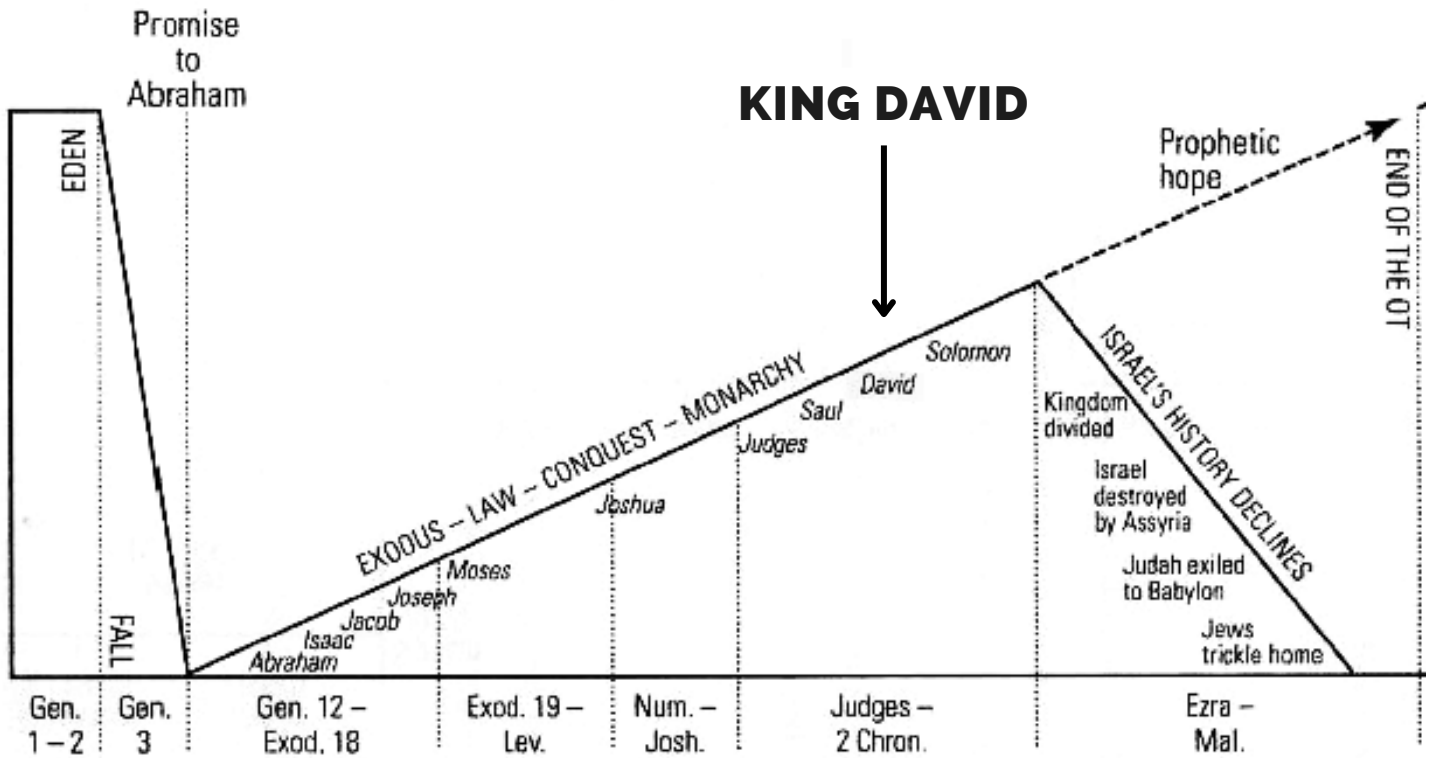

STUDY 1

Here are some areas in life where men are typically tempted to be driven by fears other than fear of the LORD. You don't have to answer all the questions but work through as many categories as you are able.

1. Work and Success

Many men feel pressure to succeed and not fail.

- Why do you think men feel such strong pressure to succeed at work or in what they do?
- What are men often afraid might happen if they fail?
- How might fear of failure instead of fear of the Lord shape the way a man works,

2. Respect and Reputation

Respect often matters deeply to men.

- Why do men care so much about respect and reputation?
- What kinds of fears sit underneath the need to be respected by others?
- What do we do when we fear the opinions of others more than God?
 - Can you think of examples from your own life?

4. Weakness and Vulnerability

Men often avoid appearing weak.

- Why do many men struggle to admit weakness or ask for help?
- What are they afraid might happen if they did?
- What kinds of masks do people wear to avoid weakness?
- How does fearing the lord free someone from needing to protect their image.

5. Provision and Security

Providing and protecting are big pressures for many men.

- Why do men feel such pressure to provide or secure the future?
- What fears might surface when that security feels threatened?
- How do men cope with threats to their financial security when their self-worth is wrapped up in their ability to provide?
- How does it affect their giving? Ministry? Family? Godliness?
- How might fearing the Lord change how a man acts when financial pressures surface?

STUDY 2

- 1. Which areas do you struggle the most to stand firm for Christ?**
- 2. What false belief(s) about God is driving that fear?**
- 3. What realities about God have helped David avoid ungodly fear.**
- 4. What difference would it make if a man's deepest concern was honouring the Lord rather than protecting himself?**
- 5. What does it look like to seek peace and pursue it? What are the risks?**

SUNDAY MORNING

Personal Reflection

Where in your life right now are you most tempted to act out of ungodly fear rather than fear of the Lord?

Men tend not to use the language of fear, but things like pressure, stress, strain, "under the pump"

Consider the following questions on your own:

- Where are you feeling pressure right now?
OR what areas of life most regularly bring pressure?
- What feels at risk or threatened? What are you trying to protect?
- What would be the worst thing that could happen if this went badly?
- And what might you lose if that happened? And what might that say about you?

So what is the deeper fear that motivates?

Often:

- Fear of failure
- Fear of rejection
- Fear of shame
- Fear of losing control
- Fear of meaninglessness

**How does fear shape the way you responded/respond to that situation?
Do you put on a disguise? Did you become defensive, controlling, withdrawn,
procrastinate, or try to prove yourself, overwork?**

What false beliefs are driving this fear?

What would trusting God have looked like in that situation?

What truth about God do you need to remember?
